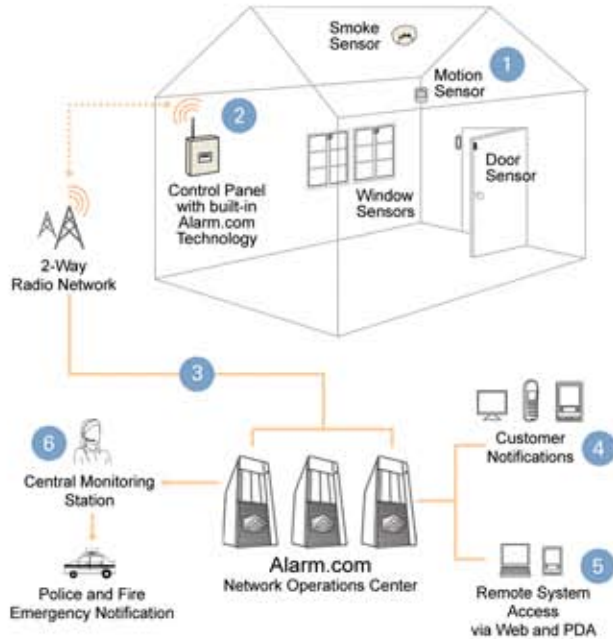


How Alarm.com Works



1. Sensors in the home or business report activity to the Alarm.com-enabled security control panel.
2. The Alarm.com Wireless Module inside the security control panel analyzes the data coming from the sensors.
3. Activity data is transmitted securely to Alarm.com using a nationwide radio network. This data is processed and stored in the Alarm.com Network Operations Center.
4. System activity (like alarms, sensor activity, power failures, system arming and disarming and more) can be reported to the customer via phone, e-mail, or text-message notification in real-time according to the customer's notification settings.
5. A Web-based user interface allows the customer to maintain complete control of the system at any time from any location.
6. Alarm signals can be forwarded immediately from Alarm.com to the Central Monitoring Station. A live operator at the Central Monitoring Station can then notify the police or fire authorities.
